
As a member of the wwPDB, the RCSB PDB curates and annotates PDB data.

Introduction

The Electron Microscopy Data Bank (EMDB) is a public repository for electron microscopy density maps of macromolecular complexes and subcellular structures. It covers a variety of techniques, including single-particle analysis, electron tomography, and electron (2D) crystallography.

The EMDB was founded at EBI in 2002, under the leadership of Kim Henrick. Since 2007 it has been operated jointly by the <u>PDBe</u>, and the <u>Research Collaboratory for Structural</u> <u>Bioinformatics (RCSB PDB)</u> as a part of <u>EMDataBank</u> which is funded by a joint NIH grant to PDBe, the RCSB and the <u>National Center for Macromolecular Imaging (NCMI)</u>.


- Offers 4 degrees of freedom for electrode placement

- Range of Motion of x-axis = 37 mm (~1.4 inch)





